If you are interesting in being baptized, please see Pastor Kevin.


## **Back To School Giveaway**

# A Season of Change

A lot has changed at Ney Church of God over the past month—especially in the area of our Audio/Visual capabilities. One of the most significant updates has been the removal of our large, outdated analog soundboard. While that board served us faithfully for many years, its age had begun to show. It has now been replaced with a modern digital soundboard that offers far greater capabilities while taking up only one-third of the space.

We've also upgraded our computer systems. Previously, we had two computers in the sound booth—one to run slides and another to record sermons for our shut-ins. This month, we've consolidated those functions into a single, more powerful computer. While the sound booth may now look more complex at first glance—as if you might need a sound engineering degree to operate it—the upgrades have actually streamlined many of our processes.

We ask for your patience as we continue to work out the bugs in this transition. Keep in mind, we're shifting away from systems we've used for the past 15 years. These previous systems were well established, so the changeover does come with some challenges.

We are excited about the opportunities these changes bring to enhance our worship experience and expand our ability to reach others—both inside and outside the church walls. These upgrades are part of our ongoing effort to serve with excellence and steward our resources wisely.

Thank you for your support, understanding, and grace as we continue to learn and grow through this season of transition. We believe God is preparing us for even greater things ahead!

#### **Mission Committee Update**

Last month this article spoke about one activity that the mission team oversees, the funding of local individuals' needs. This month we will pick up that topic to expand upon it.

BobbiJo Barbee facilitates the mission team and Cathy Leu writes the checks (treasurer). Since most individual needs are pressing and require a timely response, team protocol tries to be as flexible as possible. BobbiJo contacts members when she receives a request for funds and members consider the need. Members desire to lovingly honor each person in need as a child of God while understanding the importance of being good stewards of Abba's money and discerning His will. Team members take time to discuss and ask questions about the request. A decision is proposed then voted on. A simple majority is required for passage.

There are seven people on the team. (Their names were published in last month's newsletter). Sometimes a person is invited to join but it is not necessary to wait for an invitation. If you are interested in missions and would like to serve on the mission team, contact someone on the team. Candidates are submitted and vetted by the church council. Next month: other responsibilities of the mission team.
