



Through Their Eyes – Week 1: Mary & Faith in the Impossible

Text: Luke 1:26–38

1. Opening Reflection

- When in your own life have you realized that God was working only “in the rear-view mirror”?
- Share a moment that first felt ordinary—or even difficult—but later proved to be meaningful in your faith.

2. Discussion Questions

A. God Steps Into Ordinary Moments

1. Mary lived in an unremarkable town with no status. Why do you think God delights in using ordinary people and ordinary places?
2. What “ordinary” or overlooked areas of your life might God want to use right now?

B. Fear and Confusion Are Human

1. Verse 29 says Mary was “greatly troubled.” Why is it important to acknowledge fear or confusion in our walk with God?
2. What fear keeps you from stepping into something God may be calling you toward?

C. God’s Plan Is Bigger Than Our Ability

1. The angel’s message to Mary was overwhelming. Have you ever felt called to something that felt bigger than your ability?
2. Why does God so often ask us to do what we cannot do alone?

D. God Provides His Presence and His Proof

1. What reassurance does God give Mary in verses 35–36?
2. Where have you seen God give “proof” or reminders of His presence in your life recently?

3. Personal Application

1. What is one area where you feel God nudging you to say, like Mary, “I am the Lord’s servant... may it be to me according to Your word”?
2. What next step of obedience can you take this week?
